



Family Participation Expectations

Laguna Youth Baseball families play a huge role in the success of our league. LYB is run 100% by volunteers. We cannot run a league this size (547 players/46 teams) without your help. Throughout the season, there are a variety of opportunities for everyone to participate and contribute to the success of our teams and Laguna Youth Baseball.

What is the expectation during the season?

Parents are required to help with the following duties. Team Manager, Assistant Coaches, or Team Parents should not be the persons volunteering for said duties. They are already giving up much of their personal time to volunteer in LYB and additional help is a necessity.

- **Pre-Game and Practice Field Prep** - 3-4 persons to water, rake and stripe
- **Pre-Game and Practice Field Breakdown** – 3-4 persons to water, rake and put bases away, & cover mounds with tarp.
- **Snack Bar** (Shifts will be scheduled, and dates provided to each team) 2 adults 1 over 14
- **Fields Day Pre-season cleanup (3/1/2025)**
- **Rookie/Single A** – Assisting with stations or any field assistance the coach needs
- **Scorekeeper** – 2 per team (AA-Majors)

During TOC's AA – Majors teams will be assigned additional snack bar shifts which will require team volunteers.
