



HOME RUN DERBY & PICTURE DAY APRIL 12, 2026

Schedule will be released shortly with the teams picture time and HR Derby time.



We start with the Rookie division!

All players will receive the Memory Mate. Additional picture packages will be available for purchase.



- Money raised will determine number of pitches they are pitched
- **EVERY** player will get five (5) pitches even if the player doesn't raise any funds
- The first \$25.00 raised gets the player another pitch and every \$50.00 raised after that gets the player another pitch
- **EXAMPLE:** Little Johnny raises \$89.00 dollars - he will get 7 pitches
- For every player that raises \$50 or more, they will receive a prize

WINNERS



Home Runs will be tracked by volunteers on the field. Players with the most HR's will move to semi-finals or award ceremony depending on # of HR's.

Home Run line is different for every division.

If there is a tie, the players will get another 5 pitches to determine the winners!

There will be an award ceremony at the end of each division's derby.

The winners from each division will win a trophy, while second place and third place from each division will win a medal.



How do we raise donations?

- A link to each player's personal 99Pledges.com page will be e-mailed to their parent(s) approximately one (1) week after Opening Day
- Parents can then forward that email link to family, friends and co-workers and pledges will be made directly to that player's page. It can also be shared on social media as well.
- For every \$50 raised the player gets a raffle ticket to enter our large drawing.
- This year we will have an opportunity to buy raffle tickets at the event for a drawing. This will not go toward the player.



- Expectation that all teams will provide volunteers for every shift the team is assigned, typically one to two shifts during the season
- Each snack bar shift will need 3 or 4 volunteers depending on the day/time, only one can be a teenager (at least 14 years old) and cannot work the register
- The Team Parent of each team will be the main contact for the snack bar managers to ensure slots are filled
- SignUpGenius website will be used to schedule shifts, please make sure all volunteers enter their personal info so we can send text reminders the day before your assigned shift
- If your team has difficulty getting volunteers for your assigned day/time, you must work out a trade with a different team and inform the snack bar managers
